Hospice can also provide services in most area nursing homes, and can hospitalize patients for symptom control and care giver respite. Hospice provides case management to ensure continuity of care in all settings. Bereavement services are available for a year following the death.
Comments	Medicare, Medicaid and most insurance companies have a hospice benefit. For persons with no coverage, or when the cost of care exceeds reimbursement, the support of Blessing Foundation allows hospice to meet those needs regardless of ability to pay. Included in the hospice benefit are professional services from hospice, any needed medical equipment such as oxygen or a hospital bed, all medications related to the terminal illness, medical supplies, home health aides for personal care, volunteers and bereavement services. Families can keep their own doctor while on the hospice program.

Fee	There are no program fees associated with the YWCA Supportive Housing Program. Families that do enter the program must be able to pay a portion of their utility bills after 30 days. A security deposit and utility deposit are also required but the family has six months to meet that requirement. All families are required to put 75% of their income after essential expenses toward debt and savings.
Services Provided	The YWCA Supportive Housing Program provides leased housing that is 100% funded by the U.S. Dept of Housing and Urban Development. The homes are fully furnished and are located in Quincy, Illinois. In addition to housing, the program provides an array of supportive services designed to address the conditions that rendered the family homeless in the first place. This includes direct provision or subsidies for utilities, childcare, educational expenses, vocational training, employment expenses, food, home maintenance supplies, transportation, mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment and other healthcare related expenses
