There must be arrangements for a capable care giver, and the family needs to share the hospice goal of enhancing the quality of life without pursuing treatments that prolong death.
Fee	Hospice is a benefit of Medicare, Medicaid, and most insurance plans.
Services Provided	Offers terminally ill patients and their families education about how to adapt as the illness progresses, pain and symptom management, emotional and spiritual support, with the goal of allowing the patient to remain at home. Hospice can also provide services in most area nursing homes, and can hospitalize patients for symptom control and care giver respite. Hospice provides case management to ensure continuity of care in all settings. Bereavement services are available for a year following the death.
Comments	Medicare, Medicaid and most insurance companies have a hospice benefit. For persons with no coverage, or when the cost of care exceeds reimbursement, the support of Blessing Foundation allows hospice to meet those needs regardless of ability to pay. Included in the hospice benefit are professional services from hospice, any needed medical equipment such as oxygen or a hospital bed, all medications related to the terminal illness, medical supplies, home health aides for personal care, volunteers and bereavement services. Families can keep their own doctor while on the hospice program.

We also serve families who care for children and youth who require skilled in-home nursing.
Fee	DSCC's care coordination is free to all eligible children, regardless of their family's income level. DSCC may paying for eligible medical expenses, such as equipment, therapies, supplies and medical services, when families meet income guidelines.
Services Provided	DSCC staff partners with families to address a child's medical, social, behavioral, educational and financial needs. This process is called care coordination and is tailored to each family. It can include developing a care plan focused on a family's strengths & goals, accessing diagnostic testing, finding specialized medical care, helping families maximize their insurance & understand their coverage/benefits, attending educational meetings, locating community funding opportunities and preparing for the transition to adulthood.
